APPLICATION: Boom Spray, Fertigation or Aerial

CROP	RATE L/HA	COMMENT
Soil Amendment		
Broad Acre Cereals, pulses, oilseeds, lucerne, sorghum.	2.5 – 4.5	Apply to moist soil before seeding and incorporate within 48 hours if possible by seeding or other cultivation.
Irrigated Crops Cotton, potatoes, mangoes, sugar cane, bananas.	5 – 10	Where applicable, may be applied through irrigation to avoid the need for incorporation.
Horticulture Vines, Citrus, Vegetables, Trees – nut & fruit	5 – 10	Apply to soil before bud-burst. Apply post harvest to improve soil structure and plant balance
Pastures	2.5 – 4	Apply to moist soils. Grazing delay post application – NIL
Seed Inoculant	2.5 – 3.5 L/Tonne	Add product at correct rate to 7.5 litres of water per tonne of seed up the auger. Sow within 72 hours of inoculation.

STANDARD MIXING & SPRAYING INSTRUCTIONS:

1. **AGITATE CONTENTS WELL BEFORE USE.**
2. Fill tank to a minimum of two thirds with water.
3. Add other nutrients as prescribed **under agitation**.
4. Add BioAg Soil & Seed® **under agitation**, bring volume up to full.
5. **BEFORE TANK MIXING JAR TEST ALL ADDED NUTRIENTS FOR COMPATABILITY USING MIXING INSTRUCTIONS.**
6. **USE WITHIN 48 HOURS OF DILUTION.**
